

About the damage situation of the Tohoku region Pacific Ocean coast earthquake (The Eighth report)

This is the information on the impact of Tohoku region Pacific Ocean coast earthquake happened on March 11, 2011. (Information as of April 1, 3:00PM)

Nippon Chemi-Con Group would like to thank you for your encouragement to our production bases in the disaster area.

There was no personal suffering within the employees, and we are putting every effort to continue confirming safety of the employees' families as well as putting priority in supporting the local community to recover from the disaster.

Current status of production bases which are under recovery works is as shown below.

All of the production bases with facilities which are able to operate as usual have resumed production, however, the bases remain under reduced production with the effect of rolling blackouts, lack of gasoline and heavy oil supply, and concern of chemical agents and material supply shortages.

Nippon Chemi-Con Corp. Takahagi Plant (Takahagi, Ibaraki):

It is expected to take about three months to resume production.

Chemi-Con Miyagi Corp. (Osaki, Miyagi):

The company is getting ready to resume production in early April. It is expected to take about two months for normal production to be resumed.

Chemi-Con Fukushima Corp. (Nishi-Shirakawa, Fukushima):

The company has partially resumed production. It is expected to take about one month for normal production to be resumed.

Any other changes to the status will be informed accordingly.

Nippon Chemi-Con Group is putting utmost priority on reconstruction of the local community and assistance to the people in the disaster area, and will make concerted efforts to overcome this crisis. Thank you for your understanding.
